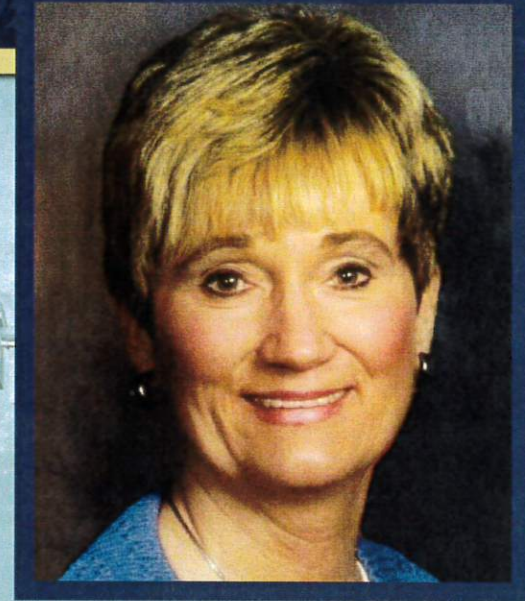

TO GUARD YOU IN ALL YOUR WAYS;
12 THEY WILL LIFT YOU UP IN THEIR HANDS,
SO THAT YOU WILL NOT STRIKE YOUR FOOT AGAINST A STONE.
13 YOU WILL TREAD ON THE LION AND THE COBRA;
YOU WILL TRAMPLE THE GREAT LION AND THE SERPENT.
